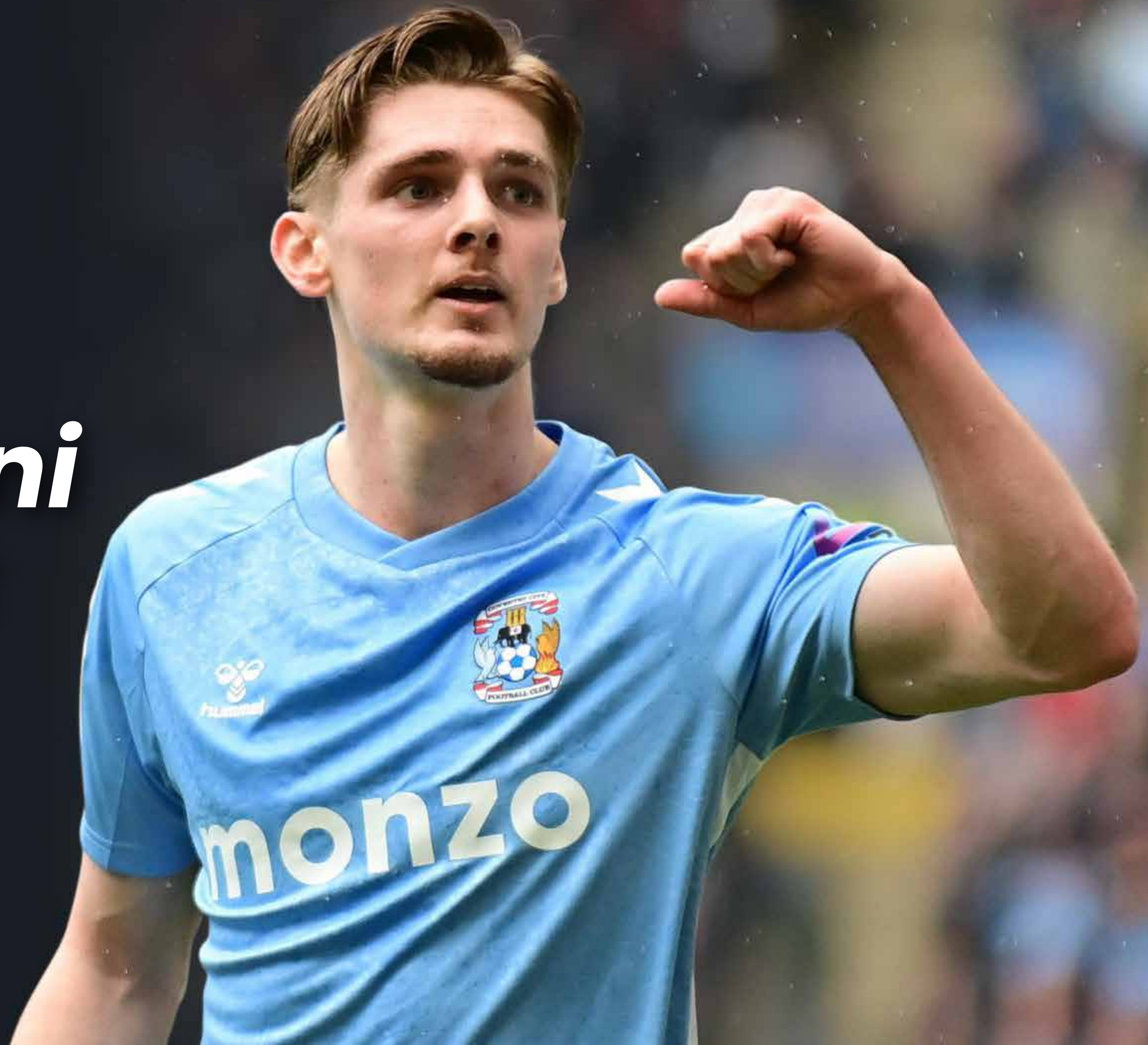

Jack Rudoni has been a revelation for Coventry City in the 2024–25 season, blending flair, intelligence, and relentless energy in the middle of the park. A master of late runs into the box and incisive final-third play, Rudoni has consistently impacted games with his vision and end product – racking up key passes, goals, and assists to rival anyone in the Championship. His technical control under pressure, combined with outstanding work rate and aerial threat, makes him dangerous in both possession and transition phases. With composure beyond his years and a growing influence in big moments, Rudoni’s playing style and Premier League-ready mentality have put him firmly on the radar of top-tier clubs eyeing creative midfielders this summer.

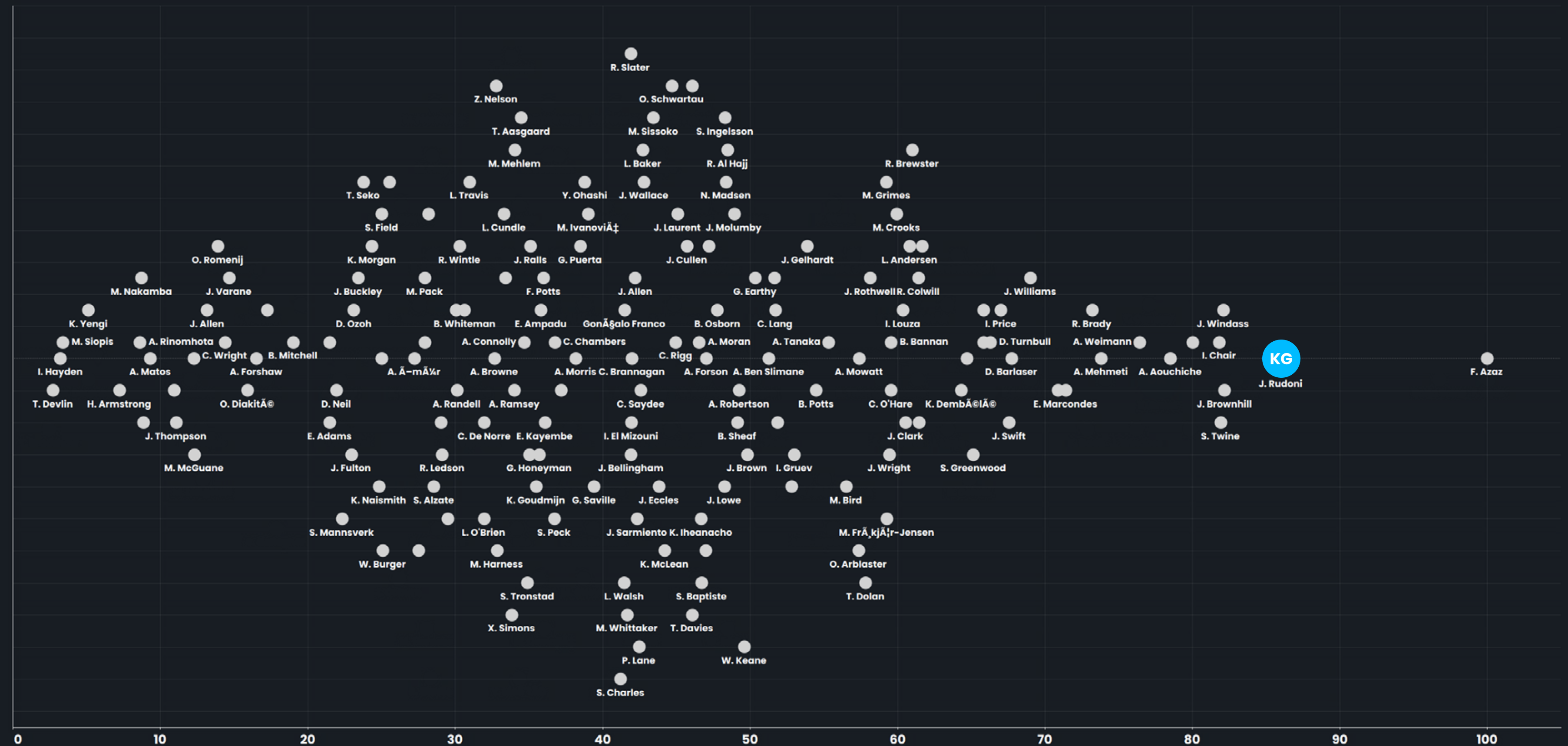

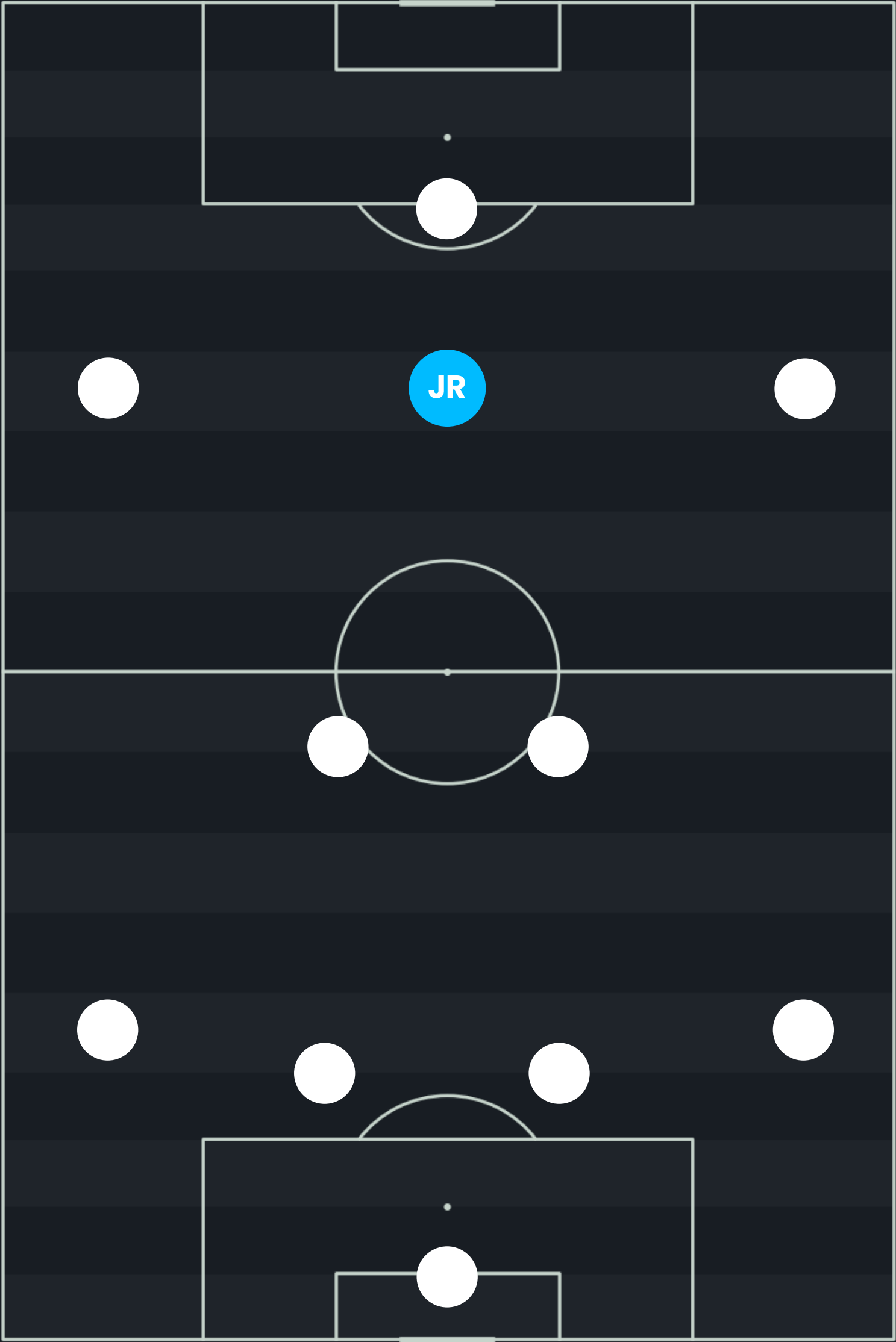
Jack Rudoni: Attacking Playmaker

As the graph shows, Jack Rudoni ranks 2nd overall among Championship-level peers when profiled specifically as an Attacking Playmaker –marking him as one the the league’s elite creators. This ranking reflects his effectiveness in combining build-up play, chance creation, attacking threat and goal contributions from advanced positions and his ability to contribute scoring opportunities for his teammates as well as score goals has highlighted Jack as one of the standout performers in a talent-rich division.

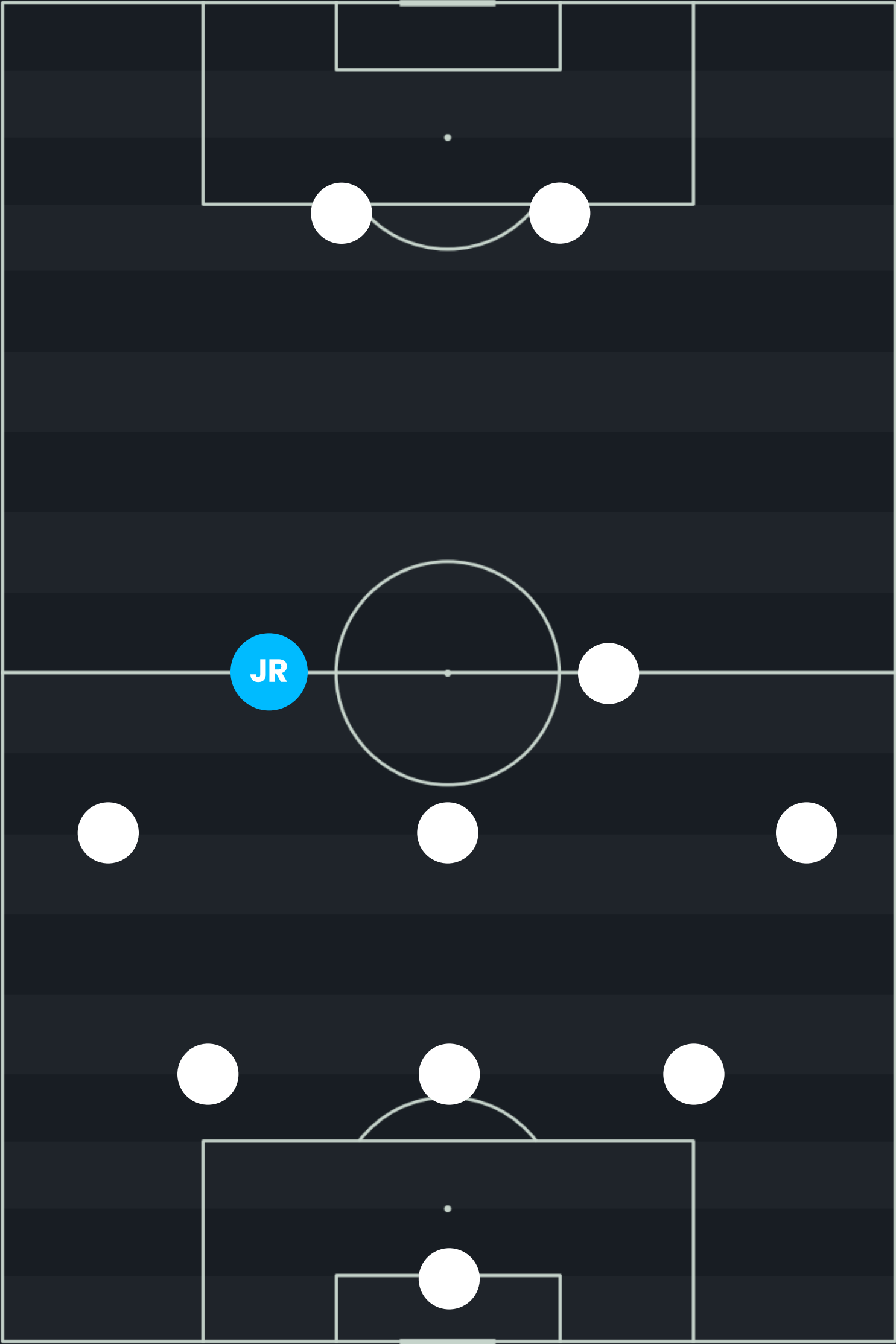

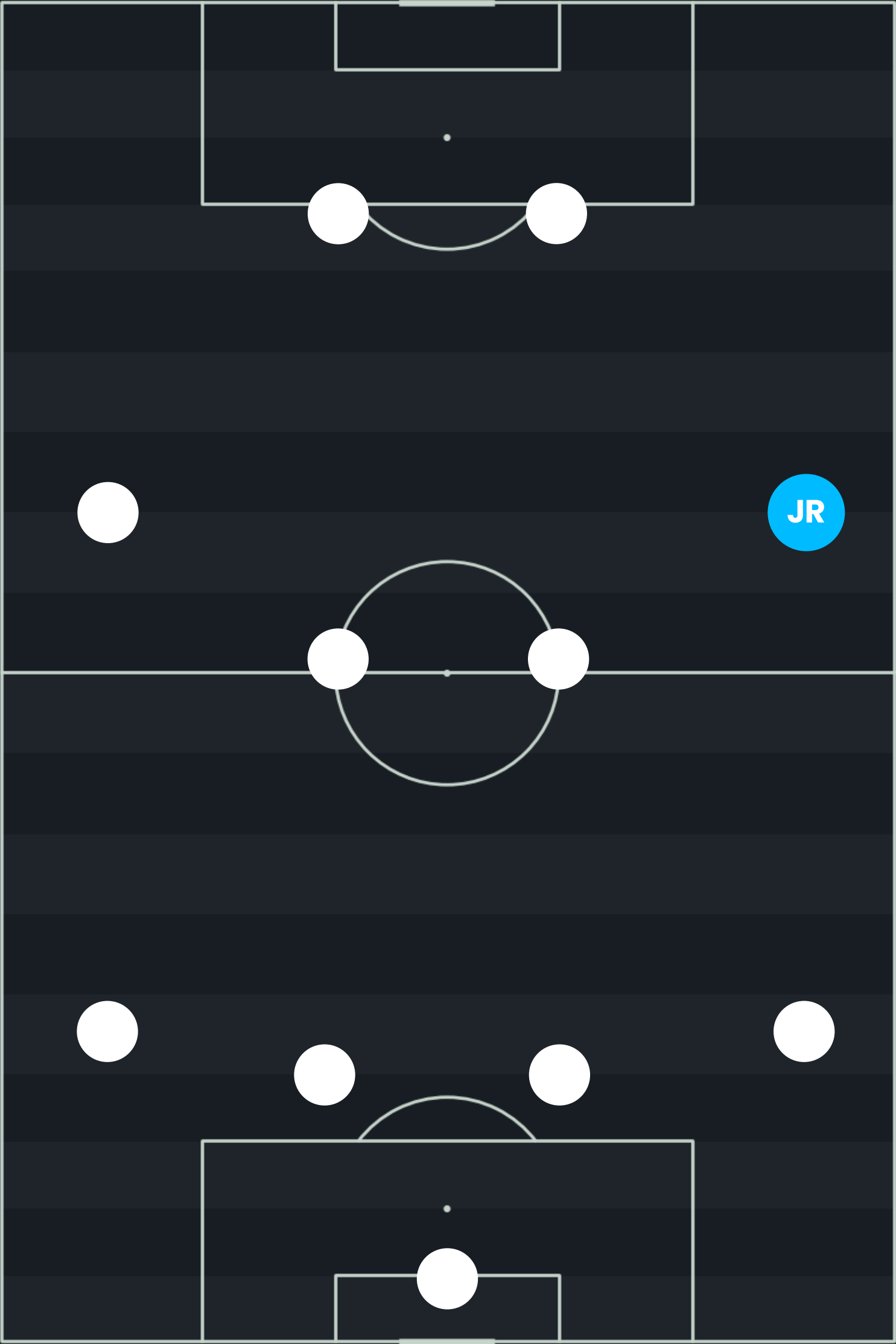

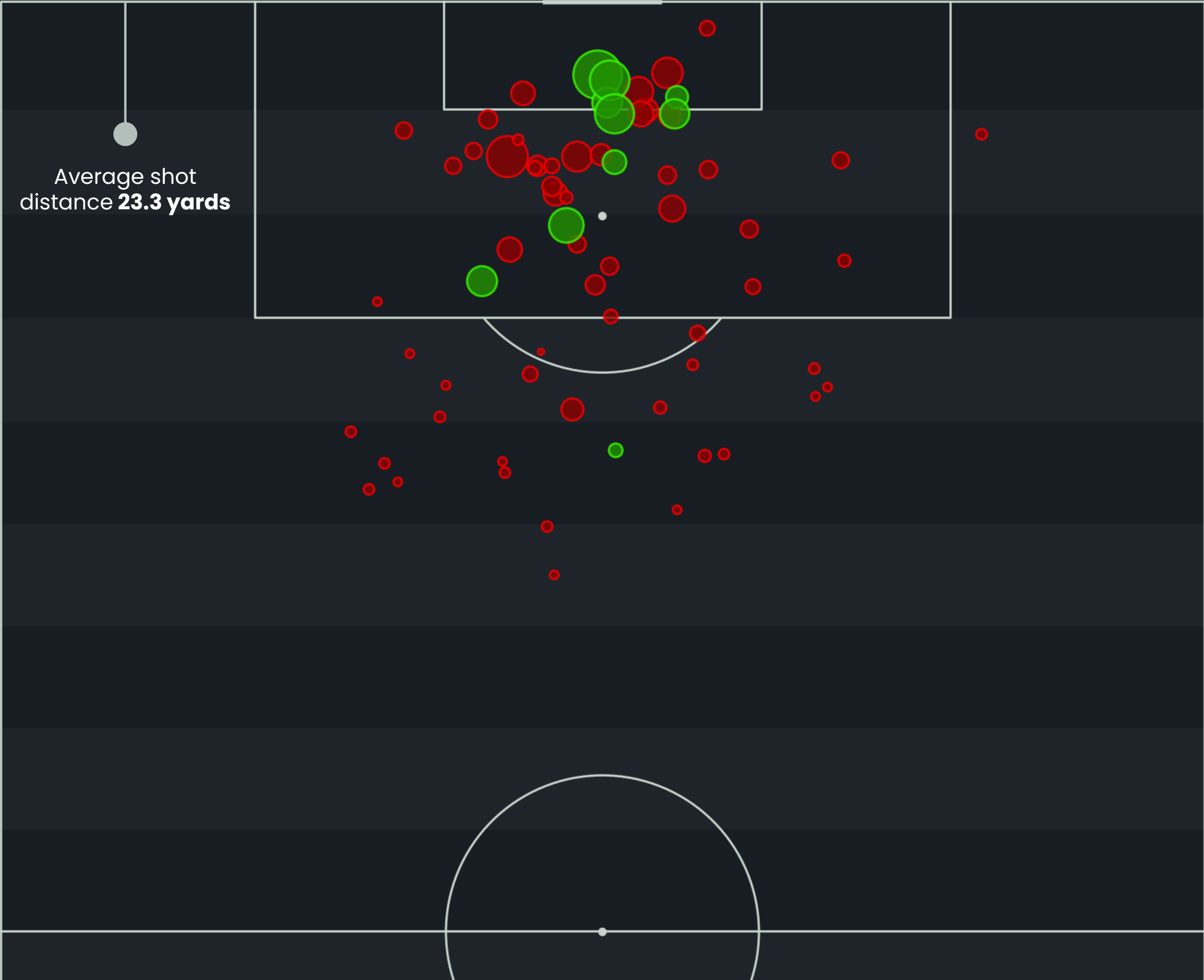

Jack Rudoni: 2024–25 Heat Map & Touch Map Analysis

Jack Rudoni's 2024–25 season with Coventry City has underlined his intelligence, technical ability, and positional flexibility. Primarily operating in the left half-space, his heat and touch maps show a midfielder equally confident drifting into central or right-sided areas when needed. Comfortable on both feet, Rudoni can receive, turn, and distribute under pressure in any direction, a key asset in high-tempo systems.

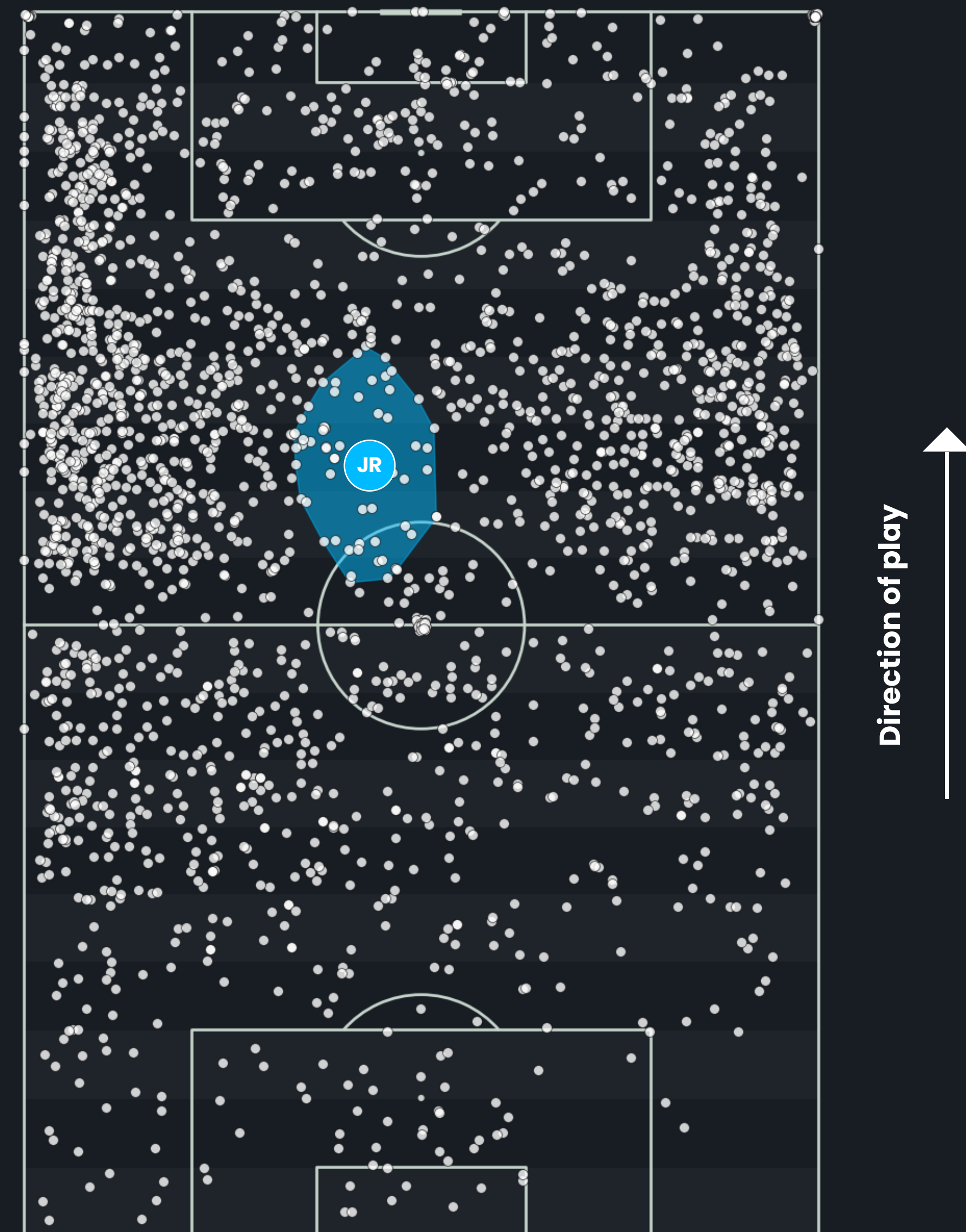
In possession, he frequently drops into deeper areas to support build-up play, progressing the ball through clever carries or incisive forward passes. His awareness between the lines allows him to link phases of play seamlessly and connect midfield to attack. In the final third, Rudoni times his late runs into the box well, often arriving unmarked to exploit space and create or convert chances. His 10 goals and 12 assists in the Championship this season reflect his ability to deliver in decisive moments.

Technically sound, tactically disciplined, and consistently influential across multiple zones, Rudoni has evolved into a complete attacking midfielder, and it's no surprise he's drawing attention from top-tier clubs ahead of the summer window.

2024–25 Heat Map



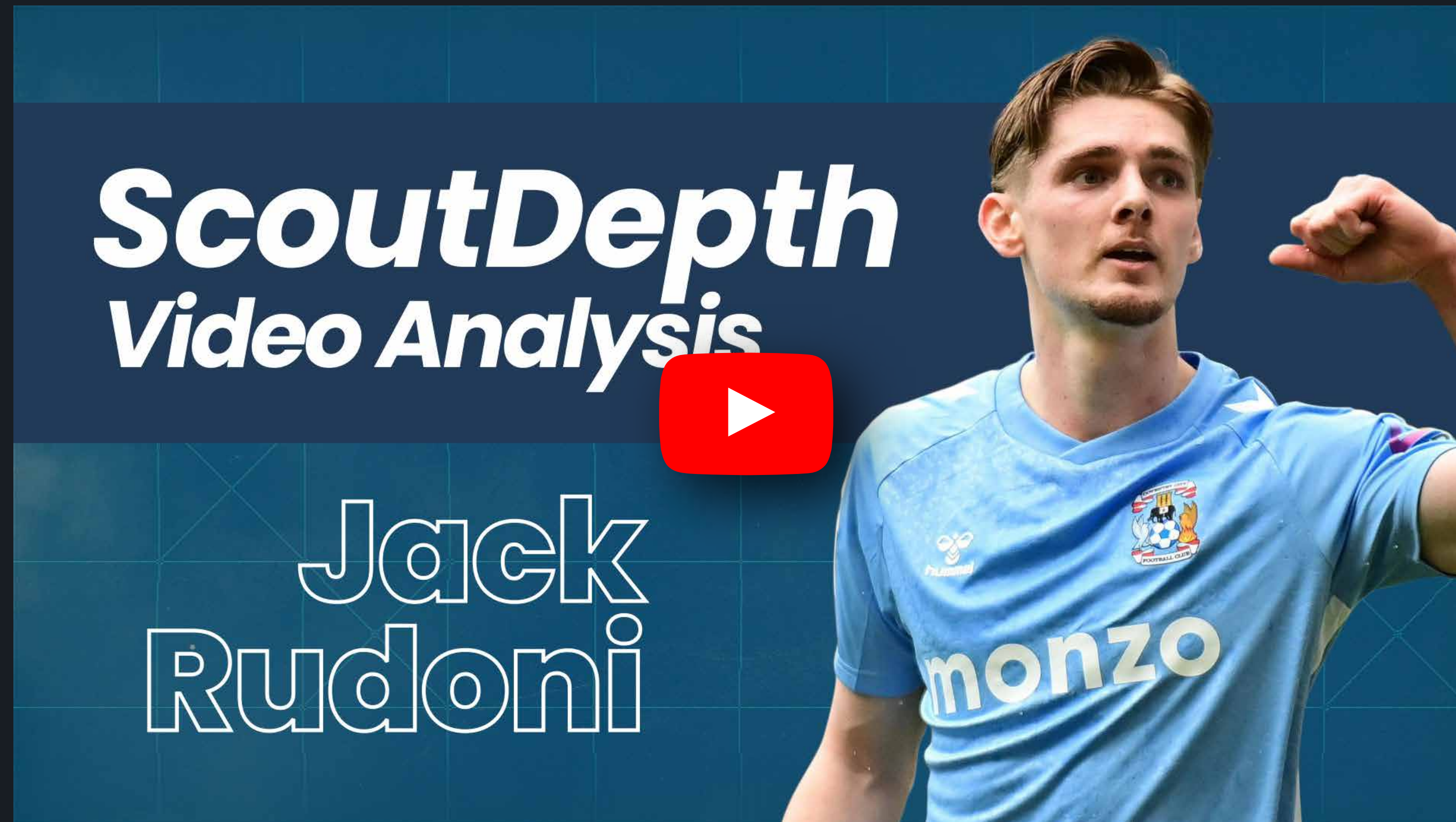
2024–25 Touch Map

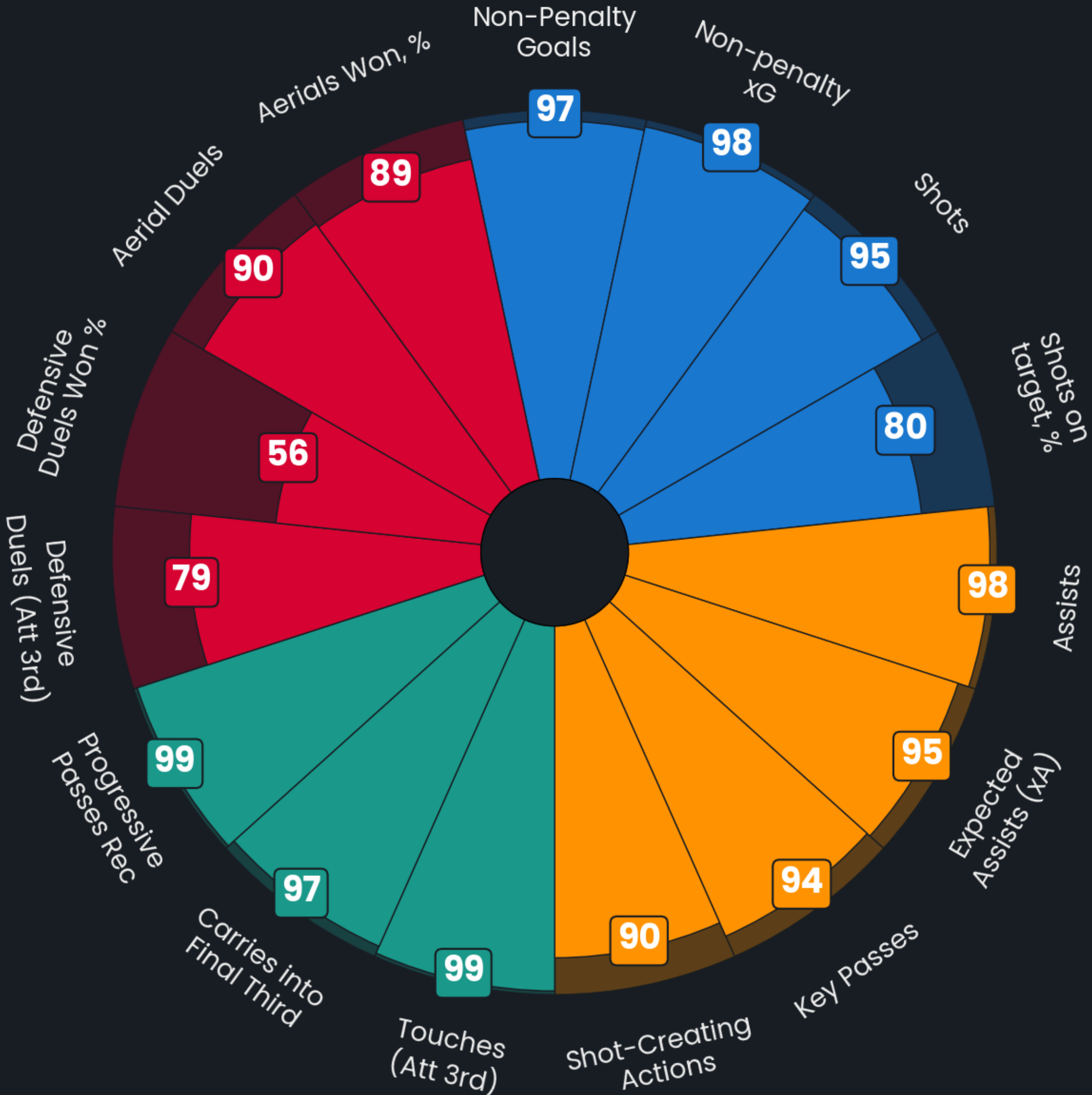

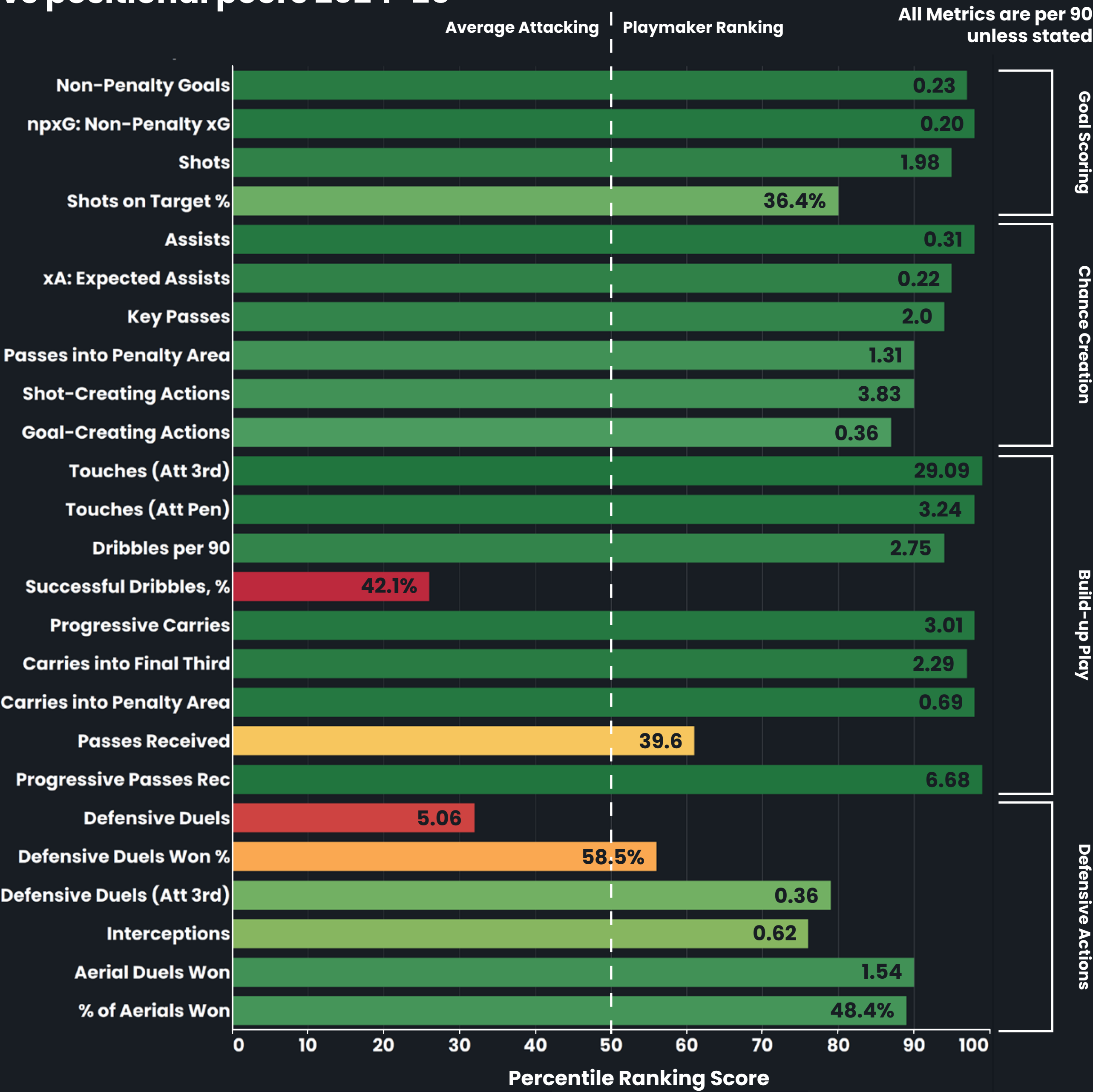


Goal Scoring Chance Creation Build-up Play Defensive Actions

Data Summary

Goal Scoring

While not a traditional forward, Jack Rudoni has emerged as a consistent goal threat from midfield in the 2024–25 season. His ability to time late runs, find space in the box, and strike cleanly has translated into standout underlying numbers among Championship midfielders.

- 99th percentile for Non-Penalty Goals per 90 (0.23)
- 98th percentile for NPxG Non-Penalty xG per 90 (0.20)
- 95th percentile for Shots per 90 (1.98)
- 80th percentile for Shots on Target % (36.4%)

What does this mean?

Rudoni consistently gets into high-value scoring areas and converts at an excellent rate for a midfielder. His non-penalty goal and xG metrics reflect sharp movement and strong positional awareness, while his shot volume and accuracy highlight his composure and technique. He adds a genuine goal threat from deeper positions, elevating his overall attacking impact.

Chance Creation

Jack Rudoni plays a key creative role in the final third, combining vision, awareness, and execution to consistently unlock defences. His ability to create chances both through passing and ball carrying is backed by elite-level metrics across several key areas:

- 98th percentile for Assists per 90 (0.31)
- 95th percentile for Expected Assists xA per 90 (0.22)
- 94th percentile for Key Passes per 90 (2.0)
- 90th percentile for Passes into Penalty Area per 90 (1.31)
- 90th percentile for Shot Creating Actions per 90 (3.83)
- 87th percentile for Goal-Creating Actions per 90 (0.36)

What does this mean?

Rudoni stands out as a creative force, regularly producing high-value chances through sharp passing and intelligent movement. His 12 assists this season reflect that impact, and the underlying metrics, from xA to key passes and shot-creating actions, confirm his consistent chance creation. He also carries the ball into dangerous areas, complementing his passing threat.

Build-Up Play

Jack Rudoni excels at finding and exploiting space in advanced areas, constantly making himself available during attacking phases. His movement off the ball and spatial awareness allow him to receive passes in dangerous zones and stay heavily involved in build-up play.

- 99th percentile for Touches in the Final Third per 90 (29.0)
- 98th percentile for Touches in Penalty Area per 90 (3.24)
- 61st percentile for Passes Received per 90 (29.9)
- 99th percentile for Progressive Passes Received per 90 (6.68)

What does this mean?

Rudoni is highly effective at positioning himself between the lines and in the box, constantly offering passing options in advanced areas. His elite ranking for progressive passes received shows how often he receives the ball in forward zones, while his touches in the final third and penalty area highlight his consistent presence where it matters most. He's a key outlet in attacking build-up and a reliable link between midfield and the final phase of play.

Ball Carrying

Jack Rudoni is a dynamic carrier of the ball, frequently driving forward with purpose and breaking lines through intelligent movement and control. His ability to progress play and commit defenders makes him a valuable asset in transition and positional attacks.

- 94th percentile for Dribbles per 90 (2.7)
- 26th percentile for Successful Dribbles % (42.1%)
- 98th percentile for Progressive Carries per 90 (3.01)
- 97th percentile for Carries into Final Third per 90 (2.29)
- 98th percentile for Carries into Penalty Area per 90 (0.69)

What does this mean?

While his dribble success rate is relatively low, Rudoni's volume and intent more than compensate. He consistently carries the ball into advanced areas, ranking among the best in his position for both final third and penalty area entries. His directness, energy, and willingness to take risks in possession help shift the momentum of attacks and create openings for teammates.

Defensive Actions

Jack Rudoni performs most of his defensive actions in the attacking area of the pitch.

- 32nd percentile for Defensive Duels per 90 (5.06)
- 56th percentile for Defensive Duels Won % (58.2%)
- 79th percentile for Defensive Duels Att 3rd (0.36)
- 76th percentile for Interceptions per 90 (0.76)
- 90th percentile for Aerial Duels per 90 (0.86)
- 89th percentile for Aerial Duels Won % (48.4%)

What does this mean?

Rudoni's defensive activity is concentrated higher up the pitch, where he presses aggressively and looks to force turnovers early. His above-average aerial presence adds value in second-ball situations, and his high interception rate shows good anticipation. While not a high-volume defender, he applies pressure effectively in attacking zones and contributes well to off-the-ball work.

Overall Summary

Jack Rudoni has developed into a complete and influential midfielder, combining creativity, ball progression, goal threat, and defensive work rate. He consistently impacts the game in the final third, registering 10 goals and 12 assists, and ranking in the top percentiles for xA, key passes, and shot-creating actions, underlining his status as an elite chance creator with genuine end product, ranking in the top percentiles for non-penalty goals.

Off the ball, Rudoni's intelligent movement allows him to receive progressive passes in dangerous areas, with a high volume of touches in both the final third and penalty area highlighting his constant involvement in build-up play. His ball-carrying metrics further reinforce his attacking value, as he regularly drives into advanced zones to unbalance defences and create openings.

Defensively, he presses high and disrupts opposition play effectively in advanced areas. While not a traditional ball-winner, his work rate, anticipation, and aerial ability make him a well-rounded contributor out of possession.
